LEVEL 4 SMALL VESSEL CHIEF ENGINEERS ST0875

Small Vessel Chief Engineers ensure the day-to-day operation of the engineering aspects of a small vessel at sea and alongside (not at sea). This includes the vessel's engine and other machinery and the technical side of 'hotel services' such as heating and ventilation.

LEVEL 3 OFFICER OF THE WATCH (NEAR COASTAL) ST0842

Includes taking charge of a vessel's safety, security and navigation during operations both at sea and in harbour.

LEVEL 2 SEAFARER (DECK RATING) ST0274

Involves working as part of the navigation department on ships and other vessels, keeping watch, maintaining safety and security, and carrying out a range of practical tasks.

LEVEL 2 MARITIME MECHANICAL AND ELECTRICAL MECHANIC ST0276

Entails undertaking the testing, fault diagnosis and maintenance of electrical, mechanical, and fluid power equipment on ships and submarines.
